There is a local Norman. And he wants to see himself as a national Norman. And there's some nationally, the local Norman, and he gives you the things that you need. How does nationally local Norman offer more paradise to you? How does he move beyond the evolutionary imperative. Nationally the local Norman is able to crush any kind of social movement. From his point of view, politics develops on the basis of ideas. These ideas are inimical to the system. Are ways to control his representations. Individuals can easily be influenced to abandon his ideas. These are only ideas. They do not describe the actual forces that influence people's actions. They see if they think that they are in touch with those forces. Nevertheless, they do not realize that these ideas are easily manipulated. But he also promises more than that. Nationally Coco Norman has a national presence. He wishes that he was national Norman. He asked if he's national Norman. He finds other people to influence.”

“What is his extraordinary power? What does he really know? What did he tell

you? Why do you think that you know? Do you think it's a little late? Norman's already got closer to you. How you going to get them out. How are you going to get rid of those thoughts. Those are influences already here. Those behaviors have already manifested. You can't make history go away, and you can't make those ideas go away, or you can't make yourself go away. It's all there. Do you think that you'll never have to answer for your crimes? The world is going to have to answer for its crimes. Turn the lights on in the morning. You're the one who turns on the lights for everybody. You're the one to mix the coffee. You're the one who makes the honey buns. Where does it start? Who really knows? You get together with your friends. You're going to hold out. This is going to be the battle royale. All ends of the same way. He needs to leave the room. Nobody wants to hear what's going on. No one wants that kind of political change. "
