JULIE AGAIN AND AGAIN

"Julie develops this power from the fragrance of the rose. This becomes essential for her nature. She could deal with the dark forces around her, and continue to smile. Why was this moment all her? What inspiration did she have to facilitate her growth? She realized The source of this power. It was in nature, but it was more than that. This was some thing that transcended experience. She needed it. This was the testament to her existence. This was the source of her creativity. She did her utmost to rise above time. What other art did she have? She needed a float on this moment. This could help her resist any challenges. She wanted something more enduring to attest to her vision. This kind of understanding would be rooted in her being. It would be an outgrowth of her development. She recognized this motivation. It propelled her along."

"It gave her magnificence. What can any of this mean? Why did she find revelation in such an awareness. This went to the heart of this narrative. This place offered refuge. And Julie was searching for that support. She gave inspiration to others. Some people might try to put her down because her life was too rooted in the spectacle. What did they really have to offer? Julie represented perfect example of generic. She created a world fromcuriosity. And it reflected this winding journey from innocence. It embodied the realm of desire. This was entirely of the world. The beholder saw what he wanted to see. Even getting close to Julie, one cannot be sure of her nature. Like a woman. It was is if it was total control of the presentation. It added magic. It was a sense of lovely coincidence. She existed at the intersection of all these facts. It was clearly marvelous."

"What gave validity to the natural realm. Julie reflected this vitality. It expressed itself in her emotions. it was there in the magic. Julie exhibited this understanding. She built upon it. This was part of her loveliness. This was the essence of her attraction with the natural order When she felt this awareness, she battled to maintain. She recognized this fear and she did her best to address the shadows. There were so many things getting in our way. There were so many things to endre. She might not have seen this is first.
